## **Job Description**

### **Summary/objective**

Raptor Techs are responsible for the daily operations of the hospital. This includes intake, triage and treatment of new wild patients, supervising volunteers, arranging transport for injured birds and providing medical care to resident birds as needed.

### **Essential functions**

- Admit new wild patients, perform intake exams, diagnostics and develop individualized treatment plans
- Perform medical procedures on patients including wound care, physical therapy, flight evaluations etc.
- Create and maintain accurate records of patient care
- Oversee daily hospital operations during shifts
- Train and supervise volunteers
- Respond to public inquires and arranging transport for injured wild birds
- Assist with hospital tours, trail education and summer camp etc.
- Assist with caring for live prey animals
- Ensure cleanliness through the building and trail
- Attend weekly Rounds and staff meetings

### **Competencies**

- Ability to effectively communicate in a clear and effective manner with staff, volunteers, general public
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with CRC Management and Leadership Team, CRC Bird Care Team, CRC Rehab Team
- Ability to perform to high standards with tight and demanding time schedules
- Ability to effectively prioritize work goals

- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Ability to manage time effectively
- Understanding and passion for CRC mission
- Ability to work weekends and holidays

### **Supervisory responsibilities**

- Supervise Rehab and Rescue Volunteers
- Lead rehab shifts independently

### **Physical demands**

Work in this position will include sitting, walking, bending, standing, lifting weights in excess of 20 lbs., and ability to capture and restrain raptors.
